Dear Parents, Carers & Friends,

Wow what an amazing start we've had, it has been genuinely lovely to see the children back in school with no restrictions and it's so nice seeing our smiling, happy children after the summer break! We have welcomed 5 reception children who have settled in wonderfully. Welcome to Katie, James, Jack, Thomas and Eomer. We would also like to welcome 2 new members of staff, Danny Leatherland who is joining us as a trainee Teaching assistant based in the Juniors and Britt Dockerill who is joining us 2 days a week to gain experience while completing her level 2 Teaching Assistant training course. We have also welcomed Miss Wardle back and are slowly getting used to calling her Mrs Vaughan. Today we showered her with confetti and celebrated her wedding in a special assembly.

### **Swimming**

On Thursday next week we will return to our fortnightly swimming lessons at Whitby Leisure Centre. We have an earlier time slot than in previous years so we will be leaving school just after lunch and returning to school for 2.30pm latest, travelling by Esk Valley Coaches. In previous years parents were able to collect their children from the pool after swimming. As we are now swimming earlier and returning to school earlier this will no longer be possible as we will be having lessons in school after we return from swimming. All children are expected to take part in the swimming lessons and will need a bag with their swimming costume/trunks and a towel with them on Thursday morning please.

### **Forest School**

We are very happy to welcome a new forest school leader to Egton School. Caroline Barber will be joining us every fortnight on a Thursday afternoon when we are not swimming. We are looking forward to being able to spend more time learning outside again. Children will need to bring their forest school clothes with suitable footwear such as wellingtons or sturdy boots and a waterproof coat. More details to follow next week.

### **Snacktime**

For most of our children it is a long time from breakfast time to lunchtime and we find that they are able to concentrate and learn better with a mid-morning snack and drink. We suggest snacks such as fruit (dried or fresh), crackers and cheese, potato snacks or a sandwich. We ask that you do not send sweets, chocolate biscuits or high sugar items. Most children also bring a plastic bottle, or carton, containing fruit juice or water. We ask that you do not send fizzy drinks, glass bottles or cans. For the younger children please try to make sure that their snack is easy for them to open and eat independently. Thank you.

## After School Clubs

After School clubs resume on Tuesday next week including Sports Club. They run from 3.15pm to 4.15pm. If your child is in reception they are welcome to stay in school for clubs but you may wish to consider that this makes it an even longer day for them at this early stage. Clubs will run until October half term when they will cease for the winter. Please let the office know via email if your child will not be staying to take part in a club. Thank you.
