Following a recent review, NYCC have noticed that a number of eligible children are not taking up the offer of a free school meal. We know there are a variety of reasons for this and we'd like to continue to work in partnership with you to increase the numbers of children benefiting from a hot school meal.

Free school meals could save families up to £450 a year per child; a much needed financial boost due to the cost of living increasing.

Temporary Traffic Management on A171 and Egton Lane

We have been asked to share the following information with you by Anglo American who manage the local mine sites.

"A water supply is currently being installed to our Ladycross Plantation site. Yorkshire Water are managing these works and their contractor, Network Plus, began work last week.

We wanted to let you know how long the temporary traffic management measures, which will enable the necessary work to be carried out, will be in place.

There will be two-way traffic lights on the A171 for up to three weeks. After this there will be two-way lights on Egton Lane, from the A171 and moving down to our site entrance, for approximately a further four weeks.

We would like to apologise for any inconvenience."

Jewellery in School

Please could we remind everyone of the policy regarding jewellery in school. 'Jewellery is not allowed to be worn for Health and Safety reasons following a directive from North Yorkshire County Council. However a watch and small stud earrings may be worn on a daily basis but must be removed for PE.'

We have noticed a number of children wearing items such as bracelets and necklaces recently. Not only does this present a health and safety risk but also causes upset if these items get lost.

If you wish your child to have their ears pierced, we recommend that you have this done over the Summer holiday period to allow them to heal before a return to school. All earrings must now be removed for PE and Swimming lessons, we are not allowed to tape over them as in previous times.

A change to Fishy Friday

We have noticed that our school dinner uptake has increased which has been brilliant, thank you for helping to keep our school kitchen sustainable. The children are enjoying working with Julie to refine the menu. From after half term we will be making a change to Fridays and adding an alternative choice to fish fingers so that both the fish lovers and the fish haters can enjoy a hot meal on a Friday. This will alternate between sausages and pizza and we will make the children and parents aware the day before what option it is that week.

Free School Meal Eligibility

If you think you may be entitled to free school meals for your child, please use the application form which can be found on the NYCC website -<u>Free school meals | North</u> <u>Yorkshire County Council</u>.

Even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 and currently receives universal free school meals, please check your entitlement. Being eligible will mean that the school receives additional funding for your child which will go towards their learning and any additional support they may need.

To qualify for free school meals you must fulfil one of the following criteria:

- Universal Credit, provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods (£616.67 per month);
- Income Support;
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance;
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance;
- Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999;
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit;
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are also not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual household gross income that does not exceed £16,190 (as assessed by HMRC); or
- Working Tax Credit run-on, paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit. Please note that contributions-based benefits, including contribution-related Jobseekers' Allowance do not entitle you to claim free school meals.
